: **Everyone was running home and hiding indoors.**

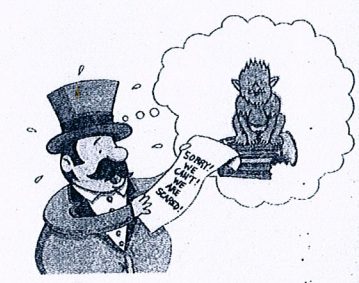
: **They were very scared.**

: **But Wolfman marched on.**


 : I am Wolfman. I eat girls for lunch and boys for dinner.

 : To the park?


 : To the school?

 : Then where?


 : People could see that he was heading for the police station.

 : He was in the back room, hiding behind the sofa.

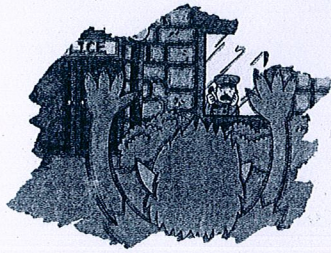
 : Wolfman marched on. He was getting closer to the police station.

 : Oh no! Wolfman is inside the building!


 : Wolfman kept moving to the back room.
