Artist Bio 藝術家簡介

出生於嘉義縣奮起湖,童年野放式的山林經驗對於今日的創作與生活型態產生了深厚的影響。

2011年因對生活與體制的質疑,自此展開了游牧式的背包客生活,足跡遍及歐美澳亞各洲,至今十餘年載。直至2020年疫情影響,暫停背包生活,返台生活創作,除了專注於工作室內的平面繪畫創作外,同時也投身於許多戶外大型壁畫創作,目前暫居於台東東河。

Born in the mountainous region of Fenchihu, Chiayi County, Taiwan. GuaGua's childhood experiences of wandering freely in the forests have deeply influenced her artistic creations and current lifestyle.

In 2011, driven by a desire to challenge societal norms and conventions, she took a leap of faith and embarked on a nomadic backpacking journey across continents traversing Europe, America, Australia, and Asia for over a decade.

The global pandemic in 2020 forced her to temporarily halt her wanderlust and return to Taiwan, where she continued to create art in her studio while also pursuing outdoor mural painting projects. Currently resides in Donghe, Taitung.

Pavel Mach

My Name is Pavel Mach, but here in Taiwan most people call me LauPau.

I originally come from the Czech Republic. I grew up, and studied in Prague, and at the age of 23 I took an opportunity to travel to England, to take care of children as a male nanny. That was the beginning of my adventurous life.

In England I realised, that I really like meeting new people, seeing new places, and learning about different cultures. I also quickly realised what school of life means. I felt like I finally start truly enjoying myself, being who I want to be, and do what makes me happy. It was hard for my family at first, but eventually they got used to it. After a year and half in England, I learned english enough to be able to travel to USA to do the same kind of thing, also taking care of children. I stayed there for over two years, and I had a great time in there. After the states, I decided to take opportunity of working holiday visa option, and traveled to New Zealand, where I experienced life of a backpacker for the first time. I bought a little camper van, and traveled around both islands for a year, during this time I also worked on different farms, and gained lots of new skills, and experience. After New Zealand I got so called traveling sickness...which basically means that you can not stop traveling, you just want to keep going! So I went to South East Asia to travel in Indonesia, Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia.

After a quick visit of my family back home, I flew to Canada for another year and half to live, work, and travel. In Canada I fully realised my love for photography, so I decided to go back into school again to study photography, which was in Australia. But before I went to Australia I went on another adventurous journey. Do you know the movie Into The Wild? Well, I got inspired by the story, I decided to hitch hike from Calgary, Canada all the way to Alaska, and find the bus where Chris Mcndless passed away, which I did. After that I hitchhiked along the west coast of the US all the way to Mexico, and then mostly by busses travel through Central America to Panama, from where I sailed on a boat to Colombia, after that I traveled through most of the countries in South America.

Well honestly, if I was going to talk about each and every country I have been to, it might not fit into four hour movie. Therefore, to make long story short. I finished 2 year photography school in Australia, went to Japan, India, Morocco, Europe, Guatemala...now it gets interesting. I had found an Icelandic coin, which for me was a sign to go to Iceland, where I met my Taiwanese wife Gua Gua. We decided to travel together..Spain, Thailand, Mianmar, Taiwan, Canada, Czech Republic until we got separated by covid19 regulations. We were not allowed to see each other cause lock downs. It took 18 months for us to finally find a way to see each other again.

During the time we were separated I took the opportunity to hike PCT, the famous Pacific Crest Trail. I have always felt very connected with nature, that's where I feel fully myself, and really

happy. Therefore walking 1600km in across two states during cover time, was the best choice for me. I had an incredible experience, and since then something is pulling me to do similar journeys, therefor I recently went to Nepal, to hike the famous Annapurna Circuit. In this upcoming April, I am going to Turkey to hike 500km along the coast. So I hope I was able to give you a bit of an idea who I am. I am someone that loves living adventurous life, sharing what we are through being nice, serving, and helping to those who need it.
