

Middle School Math Gifted and Aptitude Test Policy

The purpose of this test is to determine if a student is well beyond the current curriculum level in aptitude and content knowledge and would benefit from advancement in their math curriculum.

Sixth grade students who are qualified to apply for the test to waive the grade seven math course must include all of the following:

- 1) rank in the top 3 of the **Grade 6 Q3 math grade**.
- 2) **95th Percentile or above** on the first two MAP exams(fall/winter) in grade six.
- 3) have recommendations from the current math teacher and homeroom teacher.

The test will be the content knowledge of the IBST Grade 7 Math Course, which includes the Grade 7 and Grade 8 Common Core Math Standards. It will be held on Wednesday afternoon and will be 50 minutes long. Students need to score 90% or above in order to waive Grade 7 math course.
